

Exam Results Instructions

Instructions to follow upon receiving your exam results

If you Passed

FE & FS examinees: If you would like to be certified as an Intern in Alabama, you must complete the application on our website under Applicants. You must also contact your school and have your transcript sent directly to the Board office.

PE Examinees: You will receive a letter within 3 weeks instructing you to submit the \$75 licensure fee. Upon receipt of the licensure fee, your license number and wall certificate will be issued.

PS Examinees who took the PS exam or ALLS exam only: You will receive a letter within 3 weeks instructing you to submit the \$75 licensure fee. Upon receipt of the licensure fee, your license number and wall certificate will be issued.

PS Examinees who took the PS and ALLS exams: Allow 3 weeks to receive the results of your Alabama state-specific exam. If you passed both exams, you will receive a letter within 4 weeks instructing you to submit the \$75 licensure fee. Upon receipt of the licensure fee, your license number and wall certificate will be issued.

SE Examinees: If you made acceptable grades on the Vertical and Lateral, you will receive a letter within 3 weeks instructing you to submit the \$75 licensure fee. Upon receipt of the licensure fee, your license number and wall certificate will be issued.

If you Failed

For computer-based exams: You must log into your NCEES account and register for another exam.

For pencil-and-paper exams: If your application was approved prior to October 2014, you were approved for 4 attempts or 5 years, whichever occurs first. If this failure was your 4th attempt, you will receive a letter within 3 weeks of the exam results notifying you your application has closed. You will be required to refile an application and get Board approval prior to retaking the exam.

If your application was approved after October 2014, you were approved for unlimited attempts within 4 years. If after 4 years you have not passed the exam, your application will be closed. If this exam attempt was the end of your 4 years, you will receive a letter within 3 weeks of the exam results notifying you that your application has been closed. You will be required to refile an application and get Board approval prior to retaking the exam.

For PE and SE exams: If you have not attempted the exam within the allotted time, you will need to log into your NCEES account and register for the next exam. NCEES has registration deadlines for the April and October exams. Be sure to check the NCEES website for those deadlines.

For ALLS exam: If you have not attempted the exam within the allotted time, you will need to send the ALLS Exam Request Form and exam fee to the board office and you will be provided with further instructions. The form can be found on the website under Applicants then under PLS/ALLS Application Forms.
