

**MINUTES OF FOURTH MEETING
2014-2015 BOARD OF LICENSURE
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
Montgomery, Alabama
June 9-10, 2015**

Acting Chair Barter called the fourth meeting of the 2014-2015 Board to order at 1:00 P.M., Tuesday, June 9, 2015 at the at the Board office in Montgomery, Alabama. The following were in attendance:

It was determined that a quorum was present. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer. Mr. Barter welcomed Mr. Whorton to the Board. Mr. Whorton replaced Mr. Foust on the Board.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed.

15-107. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson to adopt the proposed agenda. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Minutes of the third meeting of the 2014-2015 Board were received for approval.

15-108. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Christy that the minutes of the third meeting of the 2014-2015 Board held April 30, 2015 be approved as written. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Action items from previous board meetings were reviewed.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Nathan Johnson, Advisor

The Board previously authorized Executive Director to approve applications for licensure, intern certification, and examinations if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. All applications for licensure, intern certification and examinations issued since the April 30, 2015 Board Meeting were reviewed.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

- 15-109. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace that the Board ratify the approval of licenses issued since the April 30, 2015 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 15-110. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Christy that the Board ratify the approval of Engineer Intern Certifications issued since the April 30, 2015 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 15-111. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Christy that the Board ratify the approval for examination those applicants approved since the April 30, 2015 meeting and listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 15-112. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Ms. Hyde that the Board defers for licensure Gernot Komar. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 15-113. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace that the Board approves Jason Curtis Thrash to sit for the examination. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Ms. M. Elisabeth Hyde, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board was briefed on the 2014-2015 statistics. The status of the investigations that were complete but were waiting disciplinary hearings was discussed. The Board discussed the investigation process and the number of technical advisors. It was noted that the number of technical advisors has been on the decline and that it would be beneficial to get additional advisors.

The Board discussed in general what was meant by standard of care and specifically the investigation process when standard of care was involved. Standard of care can be generally defined as what another licensee would have done in a similar situation. In general, investigations involving standard of care were not as easy to investigate as an investigation involving competency. Technical issues are areas where technical advisors can provide a thorough review citing standards and references. Standard of practice issues are more of a judgement call. The board members discussed how they envisioned the investigative process to work with the proposed changes to the investigative committee. It was the consensus of the Board that the board member on the investigative committee would be replaced with another board member on cases that involved questions on standard of care when a unanimous decision of the investigative committee could not be reached.

The Board discussed an issue regarding engineered truss drawings where it appears the company is using drawings originally sealed by a professional engineer who has been deceased for many years. The Board discussed that professional engineers should be involved in the design of trusses. It was suggested that even though the Board took a position many years ago that truss design was the practice of engineering that the Board believes it is time to revitalize the old effort. Mr. Barter identified that he would develop an address list of truss manufacturers so a new letter identifying the Board's position can be sent.

15-114. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde that a Board initiated complaint should be opened regarding a truss manufacturer using the engineered drawings of a deceased engineer as a basis for their truss designs. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action. Cases that are being recommended for closure or where they are recommendations from the investigative committee are discussed in a sanitized format so that in the event the Board suggests another course of action that the due process of the investigation has not been compromised. Respondent's information is not divulged until after a proposed consent order is accepted and a final order is approved.

15-115. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Johnson to close Case 2014-26-B with a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Christy recused.

15-116. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Grace to accept the proposed consent order and issue the Final Order for Case 2015-18-B. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. Glen A. McCord, PLS #20694 had performed a property survey which contained violations of the accepted standards of practice. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. McCord will pay a \$1,500 fine; his license will be suspended for 6 months with the suspension being stayed for 2 years; he

must submit to the Board a copy of any survey he performs during the two-year stayed suspension; the Board may randomly select survey(s) to be reviewed for compliance with standards of practice; and the consent order and final order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Barter recused.

15-117. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to close Case 2015-31-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

15-118. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Grace and seconded by Mr. Johnson to close Case 2015-32-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Marc S. Barter, Advisor

The Board previously authorized the Executive Director to issue certificates of authorization to applying firms if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. A list of the certificate of authorizations issued since the February 2015 Board Meeting were reviewed.

15-119. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde that the Board ratify the approval of Engineering Certificates of Authorization CA-4025-E, and CA-5011-E through CA-5030-E and Land Surveying Certificate of Authorization CA-1078-LS issued since the April 30, 2015 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board considered a certificate of authorization application that had exceptions.

15-120. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Grace and seconded by Mr. Johnson to approve the CA application for REM Consultants PLLC. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

LEGISLATIVE – Ms. M. Elisabeth Hyde, Advisor

The Board was briefed on legislation that has been filed during the 2015 General Session. The session has concluded and the staff will monitor the legislation that has been sent to the Governor for his signature.

FINANCE – Mr. Richard Grace, Advisor

The financial report for April 2015 was reviewed.

LAND SURVEYING – Mr. Frazier Christy, Advisor

The Board approved the results of the April PLS examination. The number of individuals sitting for the PLS exam in Alabama and nationally was discussed. The downward trend of those sitting for the exam was a concern and is one of the major reasons that the surveying task force was created.

15-121. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Christy to accept NCEES' recommended cutoff score for the PLS Examination, to approve the results of the PLS Examination given April 2015, to license those individuals who passed the PLS exam having previously passed the FLS and ALLS Exams and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing these examinations be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

ENGINEERING – Mr. Charles Willis, Advisor

The Board approved the results of the April PE examinations.

15-122. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace to accept NCEES' recommended cutoff score for the PE Examination, to approve the results of the PE Examination given April 2015, to license those individuals who passed the PE exam having previously passed the FE Exam and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing these examinations be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

CHAIR'S REPORT

The Board discussed the plans for the town hall meeting to be held later in the evening that will brief the proposed changes to the Board's Licensure Law. The PowerPoint presentation was reviewed.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:00 P.M. The meeting was reconvened at 8:00 on June 10th with the same board members being present.

CHAIR'S REPORT

The Board discussed the comments that were received at the first town hall meeting. It was determined to strike through the reference to summary suspensions since the process was already included in the Administrative Procedures Act. There was also a discussion about the philosophical difference as to whether a licensed issued was a "privilege" or a "right." It was identified that the remainder of the town hall meetings should be scheduled for August 25-28 with a start time of 5:30 P.M. Dr. Talbot will be contacted to see if he has an idea as to how to best approach the university deans to discuss how the changes may affect their institutions. It was also noted that other stakeholders need to be contacted and that the presentation needs to be changed to focus on the specific target. It was noted that some individuals had the misconception that the law changes included changes to the pathway for professional land surveying licensure. It was confirmed that the surveying task force would not be ready to include any type of changes that involve the surveying profession with this proposed legislation. The task force was asked to provide an interim report at the July board meeting that identifies the issues and a tentative schedule.

The Board reviewed the listing of committee advisors and sub-committee assignments. Committee assignments were changed due to Mr. Foust's departure from the Board. The sub-committee tasks were reviewed to determine which committees were still needed. The problem of branch offices and certificates of authorization and the differences of the two was clarified. It was determined that Mr. Barter would continue to serve as Acting Board Chair until such time as the new officers are elected and they take office on the normal October 1 rotation. Mr. Christy will move up to Acting Vice Chair.

15-123. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Grace and seconded by Mr. Christy that Ms. Hyde be appointed as Acting Board Secretary for the remainder of the 2014-2015 year. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board discussed the concerns about the requirement for professional engineers and land surveyors obtaining their contracts through the quality based selection (QBS) instead of bidding for work. It was noted that the negotiation process involved in QBS allows for a dialogue between the licensee and the client that will allow for a true grasp of the project and ultimately a better design/product. Many challenges to the QPB process were identified including the federal government soliciting bids in violation of their own federal mandates. Through the comments of the board members the main idea brought up was the lack of education. Ms. Casillas, Executive Director of ACEC, provided her comments on how her organization tries to assist in educating clients and identifying the efforts to circumvent QBS to her national office. A major education project will be undertaken that includes a meeting with the Architects Board to ask their support in educating their licensees about our requirements, a direct letter to our licensees, developing a QBS brochure, and a separate effort to educate the consumers on why QBS is the best method of procurement.
