

**MINUTES OF SEVENTH MEETING
2011-2012 BOARD OF LICENSURE
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
Montgomery, Alabama
July 26-27, 2012**

Chair Wilbanks called the seventh meeting of the 2011-2012 Board to order at 8:00 A.M., Thursday, July 26, 2012 at the Board office in Montgomery, Alabama. The following were in attendance:

It was determined that a quorum was present.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed. The new agenda items were briefed.

12-178. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Barter to adopt the revised agenda. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Minutes of the sixth meeting of the 2011-2012 Board held June 19, 2012 were received for approval.

12-179. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Foust that the minutes of the sixth meeting of the 2011-2012 Board held on June 19, 2012 be approved as corrected. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board was briefed on the investigative process. Included in the discussion was the initiation of complaints based on Board generated complaints. Board initiated complaints should not be used to circumvent that anonymous complaints cannot be accepted. The Board can generate a complaint if the information is readily available to the board staff or if the information is public record.

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board reviewed the list of those completed cases that are being monitored. The Board was briefed on the 2011 - 2012 statistics.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action.

12-180. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Mr. Willis to close Case 11-02-B with a letter of reprimand. MOTION CARRIED 4-0 with Mr. Wilbanks recused.

HEARINGS

At the request of Mr. Julio Cesar Garcia, the Board conducted a formal hearing to render a decision on Mr. Garcia's previously denied engineering intern application. Mr. Garcia appeared without counsel. A court reporter and translator were present and a transcript of the hearing is on file in the office.

The Board discussed the facts and findings of the case presented.

12-181. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board approves Julio Cesar Garcia for engineer intern certification. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board deliberated on the recommendations provided by the Administrative Law Judge in regards to Case 2012-11-B. Mr. Arnold was recused.

12-182. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Dr. Turner to find Mr. Robert Alan Walz, PE #24958 guilty of the charges and to agree with the Administrative Law Judge's conclusions and recommendations with modifications. Mr. Walz's professional engineer license will be revoked, he shall pay to the Board a \$2,500.00 fine within 30 days of the final order, and shall pay to the Board \$1,000 for the cost of the hearing within 30 days of the final order. MOTION CARRIED 4-0 with Mr. Arnold recused. (Case 12-11-B)

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor

12-183. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Willis that the Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors go into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing pending applications. Misters Arnold, Barter, Foust, Wilbanks and Willis and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Wilbanks announced the Board would reconvene into open session at approximately 12:00 P.M. The meeting was closed to the public. The meeting was opened to the public at 12:00 P.M. The Board recessed for lunch and the Board meeting reconvened at 1:00 P.M.

12-184. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors go into Executive Session

for the purpose of discussing pending applications. Misters Arnold, Barter, Foust, Wilbanks and Willis and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Wilbanks announced the Board would reconvene into open session at approximately 2:00 P.M. The meeting was closed to the public. The meeting was opened to the public at 1:45 P.M.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(4) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

- 12-185. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board accept for licensure by comity those applicants listed on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 12-186. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Willis that the Board accept for EI/LSI certification those applicants listed on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 12-187. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board denies for licensure Mr. William Nhon Dang, Mr. Christopher Ronald Mann, and Ms. Mary Monica Barber. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 12-188. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Willis that the Board approves for examination those applicants listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 12-189. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board defers for examination those applicants listed as deferred on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

12-190. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board denies for examination those applicants listed as denied on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed requests for board evaluation of transcripts from applicants who wished to be considered for engineering licensure on the basis of obtaining a related science undergraduate degree plus a master in engineering.

12-191. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Willis that Jeremy Dwain Driver's degree and Dominick Viruleg, Jr.'s degree be approved as related science degrees as they apply to engineering licensure. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Marc S. Barter, Advisor

12-192. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Board ratify the approval of Engineering Certificates of Authorization CA-4450-E through CA-4461-E and Surveying Certificate of Authorization CA-583-S issued since the June 19, 2012 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

LEGISLATIVE – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The dates for the 2013 Legislative Session were briefed. Proposed changes to the Licensure Law were discussed. The executive director will draft the changes and begin the process of having legislation prepared.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

The Executive Director briefed the Board on the status of the 2011 Immigration Law which requires the licensing board to determine the immigration status of the applicants prior to the issuance of licenses. Portions of the 2011 law are still under legal challenge but the section requiring the immigration declaration has been upheld. The board's application to the federal SAVE program is still pending. The staff's proposed procedures for compliance were discussed. Effective immediately professional licensing applications will include a declaration statement, all pending applications will not be presented to the Board for approval until they have the declaration statement, 2013 renewals and reinstatement forms will have the declaration added, intern applications will not include the statement since they are not considered a professional license, and certificate of authorization applications will not include the statement since the principal will already be compliant. The declaration statement was reviewed by the board's attorney who identified he believed it met the requirements of the law. The status of non-U.S. citizens will not be checked until such time as the board office is approved to use the SAVE program.

12-193. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Arnold to approve the declaratory statement and the procedures for immigration compliance as outlined by the board staff. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Board staff asked for guidance from the Board on how to proceed with enforcing the protection of the "engineering" title. The staff was asking on how to proceed when it is determined that the title "engineer" is being used by someone who does not hold a professional engineering license. The Board instructed the staff to continue the process currently in use to gain compliance.

NEW BUSINESS

The Board was asked if a certificate of authorization was required for subcontractors to a prime contractor of a federal contract. Previously it was determined that contractors on a federal contract were exempt from licensure law requirements. The question now being asked was if a subcontractor was also exempt. The Board concurred with the legal opinion that a subcontractor who was only performing services for the federal contract was also exempt. It was noted that when looking at revisions to the licensure law that the federal exemption should be reworded based on the ruling that federal contractors were exempt.

LAND SURVEYING – Mr. C. Michael Arnold, Advisor

The board was briefed on the continuing efforts to revise the state specific land surveying examination. The test questions continue to be reviewed and the next major action item is to have a session to set the passing score based on the administration of a trial exam. The committee proposes that the session be done in conjunction with the fall ASPLS meeting with the board defraying any costs that may be incurred including the paying mileage for the session participants. The Board also authorized continuing education credit for the individuals participating in the session.

12-194. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Foust to approve the rewrite efforts of the state specific land surveying examination as outlined. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board meeting adjourned at 5:40 P.M. The Board reconvened at 8:00 A.M. on Friday, July 27, 2012 with the same individuals in attendance.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The Board elected officers for 2012-2013.

12-195. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Arnold to elect Dr. Turner as Chair. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

12-196. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Willis to elect Mr. Santora as Vice Chair. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

12-196. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Dr. Turner to elect Mr. Foust as Secretary. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The agenda for the 2012 NCEES Annual meeting was reviewed.

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY – Mr. Earl R. Foust, Advisor

Results of the 2012 continuing professional competency audit were briefed. Of those who were selected for audit, four responses were determined to be non-compliant by the staff. The non-compliant issues were briefed to be Board. The first two licensees have failed to provide documentation for the continuing education claimed. The third licensee identified an error when calculating the number of hours claimed. The fourth licensee had to correct the number of hours that had been claimed.

12-197. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Willis that licensee #1 and #2 have their licenses temporarily suspended and initiate complaints, licensee #3 is notified that he must obtain 15 PDH prior to October 1, 2012, and that licensee #4 is notified that he must obtain 4 PDH prior to October 1, 2012. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

FINANCE – Dr. Daniel S. Turner, Advisor

Financial reports for May and June 2012 were reviewed.

The 2013 OPLAN was briefed. Questions were raised about how much liability coverage the board had if sued. The executive director was tasked to research the current coverage. Plans for additional enforcement efforts were discussed. The enhancements to the investigative process included the possible use of technical advisors in the field, publicity campaign, and a board vendor table at various state conferences.

12-198. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Willis to approve the 2013 Operations Plan. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Board reviewed correspondence from Mr. Bill McGrath, NJ Society of Professional Land Surveyors, who had written an article where he was concerned about the increasing use of individuals providing brokering services. The current status of the Board was confirmed that if a brokering firm does not have a protected term in its name it does not need a CA if it is only providing the brokering service but that the actual provider of the service needs to be licensed in Alabama.

Mr. Willis was selected to replace Mr. Don Arkle as the board liaison to the University of Alabama Department of Civil, Construction, and Environmental Engineering Advisory Board.

The Board reviewed various newsletters that required no response.


OPEN FORUM






