

**MINUTES OF FIRST MEETING
2013-2014 BOARD OF LICENSURE
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
Montgomery, Alabama
October 9, 2013**

Chair Santora called the first meeting of the 2013-2014 Board to order at 8:00 A.M., Wednesday, October 9, 2013 at the at the Board office in Montgomery, Alabama. The following were in attendance:

It was determined that a quorum was present.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed. The new agenda items were briefed.

14-01. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to adopt the revised agenda. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Minutes of the sixth meeting of the 2012-2013 Board held July 24, 2013 were received for approval.

14-02. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Dr. Turner that the minutes of the sixth meeting of the 2012-2013 Board held on July 24, 2013 be approved as presented. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Actions from previous board meetings were reviewed.

The Board, at Mr. Barter's request discussed Areas of Engineering Practice and the need for the Board to develop a Position Statement. It was determined that Mr. Barter would prepare a position statement for discussion at a later Board meeting.

HEARINGS

Board was briefed that the Investigative Committee would present a proposed Consent Order in Case No. 2012-24-B, in lieu of the formal hearing scheduled for October 10, 2013.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor

The Board previously authorized Executive Director to approve applications for licensure, intern certification, and examinations if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. All applications for licensure, intern certification and examinations issued since the July 24, 2013 Board Meeting were reviewed.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

The Board remained in Open Session to review and consider applications with and without issues.

14-03. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board ratify the approval of licenses issued since the July 24, 2013 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

14-04. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board ratify the approval of Intern Certifications issued since the July 24, 2013 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

14-05. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board ratify the approval for examination those applicants approved since the July 24, 2013 meeting and listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

- 14-06. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board approve for professional engineer licensure by comity those applicants listed on **Attachment #1** MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 14-07. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board defer Fang-Fu Tang and Nicholas A. Perry for licensure and Rashad Ahmed Ansari for certification. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 14-08. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board deny Cedric D. Fairbanks professional engineer license by comity application. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 14-09. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board approve for examination those applicants listed on **Attachment #3** MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 14-10. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board deny for examination those applicants listed on **Attachment #3** and the list include William John Chancery and Marty David Bryant. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 14-11. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board defer for examination those applicants listed on **Attachment #3** and the list include Rashad Ahmed Ansari. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board was briefed on the 2012 - 2013 statistics.

The Board reviewed enforcement actions taken against Alabama licensees by other licensing jurisdictions.

- 14-12. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the cases listed as “NC1/TN1”, “OH1” “SC1” and “IA1” be cautioned to insure they comply with the Board’s law and rules when practicing in Alabama, and a copy of the letter be placed in their licensing files. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action.

- 14-13. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Mr. Foust that there was probable cause that James Harry Jeffcoat, PE # 25747 purchased an adequate number of professional development hours to allow him to meet the required number of professional development hours, but he did not complete them by December 31, 2012. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Jeffcoat will be subject to audit of the reported continuing professional competency credits twice within seven years of the date of final order, he will serve one year probation to commence immediately upon date of final order, he must submit payment of a \$1,000 fine to the Board and

the consent order and final order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Santora recused. (Case 2013-14-B)

- 14-14. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Foust to close Case 2013-22-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Santora recused.
- 14-15. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Foust that there was probable cause that Entech Engineering Inc. provided engineering services for Jim 'n Nicks Bar-B-Q in Cullman, Alabama and Jim 'n Nicks Bar-B-Q in Auburn, Alabama during a time that its Certificate of Authorization for engineering was either in lapsed or expired status. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Entech Engineering Inc. shall submit to the Board a fine of \$1,000 and the matter will become public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Willis recused. (Case 2013-25-B)
- 14-16. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that there was probable cause that Larry Edward Kincer, PE # 22040 failed to provide the continuing professional competency documents when they were requested by the Board on February 27, 2013 and April 29, 2013 due to poor record keeping. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Kincer shall be subject to future audits of reported continuing professional competency credits at the discretion of the Board, shall submit payment of a \$745.00 fine to the Board, understands that failure to comply with any terms of the consent order shall cause his professional engineer license to be revoked and the consent order and final order will become public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Christy recused. (Case 2013-27-B)
- 14-17. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Foust that there was probable cause that John Richard Rhudy, PE # 18047 failed to provide documentation that verified completion of nine (9) of the fifteen (15) PDH reported on his 2013 professional engineer license renewal application due to poor record keeping. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Rhudy shall be subject to future audits of reported continuing professional competency credits at the discretion of the Board, he shall serve one year probation, he shall submit payment of a \$1,000.00 fine to the Board, he understands he must complete nine (9) PDH and provide completion certificate to the Board within 90 days, that failure to comply with any terms of the consent order shall cause his license to be revoked, and the Consent Order and Final Order will become public record, The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Dr. Turner recused. (Case 2013-28-B)
- 14-18. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Dr. Turner that there was probable cause that William Sterling Bennett, PE # 29736 failed to provide the continuing professional competency documents when they were requested by the Board on February 27, 2013 and April 29, 2013 due to a miscommunication with his assistant. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Bennett shall be subject to future audits of reported continuing professional competency credits at the discretion of the

Board, he shall submit payment of a \$745.00 fine to the Board, he understands that failure to comply with any terms of the consent order shall cause his professional engineer license to be revoked and the consent order and final order will become public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Barter recused. (Case 2013-31-B)

- 14-19. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Foust to close Case 2013-36-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Santora recused.
- 14-20. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Dr. Turner that there was probable cause that Gerald R. Martin, PLS # 13191 received a felony criminal conviction for Sexual Abuse in the first degree in Circuit Court of Madison County, Alabama on August 22, 2012. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Martin's professional land surveyor license shall be immediately revoked, he understands that if his felony criminal conviction is overturned as a result of an appeal and his civil rights are restored he may apply to the Board for re-issuance of his license, and the Consent Order and Final Order will become public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Wilbanks recused. (Case 2013-40-B)
- 14-21. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Foust that there was probable cause that Marshall W. Corlew, PE # 11308 submitted an Application for a Permit to Install a Small Flow Onsite Sewage Disposal System to the Limestone County Health Department relative to an onsite sewage disposal system that contained errors and inaccurate information. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Corlew shall submit a fine of \$2,000.00 to the Board, he must serve two (2) year probation, he must provide documentation to the Board supporting completion of the ten (10) professional development hours continuing professional competency course sponsored by Murdough Center for Engineering Professionalism, College of Engineering, Texas Tech University within six months of Final Order, and the Consent Order and Final Order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Willis recused. (Case 2012-24-B)
- 14-22. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Dr. Turner that there was probable Cause that Cynthia Straughan and MSI Engineers, Inc, a Texas professional Engineering company, maintained an internet webpage containing language that stated "We are licensed in the states of Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, California, Florida, Hawaii, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Michigan, New York, Ohio, South Carolina, Texas, Utah, Virginia and Washington." Although the firm did employ an Alabama Licensed Professional Engineer at the time of publication, neither she nor the firm maintained a certificate of authorization from the Board authorizing it to practice or offer to practice engineering in the State of Alabama. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that the firm shall submit a civil penalty of \$1,500.00 to the General Fund of the State of Alabama, submit to the Board a certified check in the amount of \$73.07 for cost and shall continue to cease and desist the use of any language that could be construed to indicate it maintains a certificate of authorization in Alabama and will continue to do so in the future until such time as it obtains a certificate of authorization. Consent Order and Final Order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order

and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Barter recused. (Case 2013-09-C)

Benjamin Albritton, Board Legal Counsel informed the Board that Mr. Vincent Nicholson of Case # 2012-34-C had submitted documentation he wished the Board to consider during its deliberation of the findings from a hearing held on July 11, 2013. Mr. Albritton informed the Board that it could consider or not consider the additional documentation at its discretion.

14-23. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board go into executive session at 10:25 A.M. for deliberations regarding ALJ Recommended Final Orders (Case # 2012-34-C and #2013-10-C). Dr. Turner and Misters Santora, Wilbanks, Foust, Christy and Barter voted in favor of the motion.

Mr. Santora announced the Board would reconvene into open session in approximately 30 minutes. The meeting was closed to the public and Mr. Christy was recused from the Executive Session.

The meeting was opened to the public at 10:50 A.M.

14-24. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board accept the recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge and issue a Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0. Mr. Christy was recused. (Case 2012-34-C)

14-25. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board accept the recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge and issue a Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0. Mr. Christy was recused. (Case 2013-10-C)

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Marc S. Barter, Advisor

The Board previously authorized the Executive Director to issue certificates of authorization to applying firms if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. A list of 40 Certificates of Authorization issued to engineering firms (CA-4657-E through CA-4696-E) and a list of 3 Certificates of Authorizations issued to land surveying firms (CA-1032-LS through CA-1034-LS) since the July 24, 2013 Board Meeting were reviewed.

14-26. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board ratify the approval of Engineering Certificates of Authorization CA-4657-E through CA-4696-E and Land Surveying Certificates of Authorization CA-1032-LS through CA-1034-LS issued since the July 24, 2013 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Certificates of Authorization applications which had anomalies were discussed by the Board

14-27. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board deny the Certificate of Authorization application of Madison, Inc. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

FINANCE – Dr. Daniel S. Turner, Advisor

End of month financial reports for July and August, 2013 were reviewed.

LAND SURVEYING – Mr. A. Frazier Christy, Advisor

The Board reviewed the statistics for the FLS, PLS and ALLS examinations.

14-28. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Christy to accept the Board's recommended cutoff score for the ALLS Examination, to approve the results of the ALLS Exam given August 13, 2013, to license the individual who passed the ALLS Exam having previously passed the FLS and PLS Exams and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing these examinations be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

CHAIR'S REPORT

The Board reviewed the current Committee and Sub-Committee Assignments to determine if there were any changes required. Chair Santora discussed the need for sub-committee leads to set up a time frame for completion of their assigned task. Executive Director Dinger reminded the Board that under the Open Meetings Act sub-committees are a function of the board and must meet the requirements of the Open Meeting Act. If there is a quorum of the board at any meeting of a sub-committee, the meeting must be advertised. No decisions can be made at sub-committee levels that are not openly discussed at a full meeting of the board.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Robert Paul Mobley, professional engineer, submitted a letter requesting the Board consider waiving the license reinstatement fee because of an extended illness. Mr. Mobley advised in his letter that in October 2011 he was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia and began treatment 5 days later which included a number of months treatment including 4 months at MD Anderson in Houston, Texas. After review of the letter the Board determined the following motion.

14-29. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Mr. Christy to approve Mr. Mobley's request for waiver of the \$345.00 reinstatement fee, but Mr. Mobley still must submit the \$45.00 fee required for renewal of his PE license for 2013 and 2014. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board recessed for lunch at 11:30 A.M. and the Board meeting reconvened at 12:30 P.M

The Proposed 2014 Board Meeting Calendar was reviewed by the Board

14-30. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Barter to adopt the proposed 2014 Board Meeting Calendar. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board reviewed Legal Services currently being provided to the Board. Legal representation is provided through the Attorney General office and is reimbursed based on a memorandum of agreement that is executed between the two agencies.

The administrative hearing officer services being provided by Ms. Dana Billingsley is based on a personal services contract which expires in December 2013. A new contract for hearing officer

services will be required. Ms. Billingsley has identified that she is interested in continuing to serve as the Board's hearing officer.

14-31. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Dr. Turner to approve the October 1, 2013-September 30, 2014 Attorney General Interagency Agreement and authorize the staff to process a contract with Ms. Billingsley for administrative hearing officer services. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Executive Director provided a recap of information gained by those who attended the 2013 CLEAR, FARB and AARB meetings. Those who have attended gave a brief recap of lessons learned.

LEGISLATIVE – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board reviewed proposed language to finalize suggested changes to update the Licensure Law. The Board decided to introduce one piece of legislation this year. The bill would address the exam language changes and other non-controversial time-sensitive issues. Senator Allan has agreed to sponsor the legislation and wants to pre-file the bill so that it can get started in the committee process as soon as the Legislature goes into session. The Board further determined to meet with interested parties, licensees, and society members throughout the year to promote awareness of a second bill that would be introduced in the 2015 legislative session which may include controversial issues.

Mr. Barter led a discussion regarding the issue of adding Public Members to the Board. Chair Santora recognized members of the public in attendance and asked them to introduce themselves. Their names were Jennifer Sellers and Joey Breighner representing ASPLS; and Rene Casillas and Steven Speaks representing ACEC. Comments were made by each of the members of the public in attendance.

14-32. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Christy that the Board approve the recommended changes to the licensure law and to submit one piece of legislation containing only changes to testing requirements and any non-controversial time-sensitive issues. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS AND CORRESPONDENCE

It was brought to the Board's attention that some planning commissions were requiring engineering certification statements to be placed on the actual subdivision plats. It is the Board's opinion that the certification statements made by the engineers of record are engineering statements and as such should not be placed on a surveying document. Mr. Christy has drafted a letter outlining the Board's opinion. The letter was reviewed by the Board and recommendations made.

14-33. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to slightly change the introductory paragraph of the letter so that it could be sent to all the planning commissions. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board's 2011-2012 Annual Report was reviewed at the April 2013 meeting and it was determined the format should be updated. The updated Annual Report was reviewed.

14-34. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Foust that the 2011-2012 Annual Report be accepted. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

At the July 2013 board meeting, the Board made a motion to request an AG opinion to clarify design requirements in the Code of Alabama, 1975 dealing with fire alarms and the request was submitted. Attorney Benjamin Albritton, Board Legal Counsel gave a brief update on the status of the Board's request and recommended that the request be withdrawn.

14-35. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the request for an AG opinion to clarify design requirements in the Code of Alabama, 1975 dealing with fire alarms be withdrawn. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Mr. Robert Hoggle, a professional land surveyor spoke to the Board regarding a recent incident during which he was assaulted while attempting to survey a piece of property. He requested the Board consider supporting him in his efforts to amend state criminal laws to require assaults against professional land surveyors during the performance of their profession to be upgraded to felonies. The Board expressed support for Mr. Hoggle and recommended he contact his state Representative and professional societies.

NEW BUSINESS

Ms. Alexandra K. Garrett, Attorney for Cortez Fowler, Jr., Craig Fowler and Chris Fowler, requested the Board issue an opinion regarding the proposed structure of a forensic engineering consulting firm in Alabama. Her client wished to incorporate a company called Forensic Consulting Group, LLC ("FCG") in Alabama. The firm's main business purpose would be to perform property damage assessment for the insurance industry, including issuing opinions on the cause and origin of any damages. The firm would not be engaged in planning, permitting, or engineering design offerings. Its service offerings would be limited to damage observations and damage assessments. The firm would not maintain a physical office in Alabama. Instead, it would operate from an office where its Alabama licensed professional engineer resides. After reviewing the information you provided, Title 34 Chapter 11 Code of Alabama 1975 and its Administrative Code the Board determined the firm structure described meets the Board's requirements for issuance of a certificate of authorization.
