

**MINUTES OF SECOND MEETING  
2013-2014 BOARD OF LICENSURE  
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS  
Montgomery, Alabama  
December 4, 2013**

Chair Santora called the second meeting of the 2013-2014 Board to order at 8:00 A.M., Wednesday, December 4, 2013 at the at the Board office in Montgomery, Alabama. The following were in attendance:

It was determined that a quorum was present.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed. The new agenda items were briefed.

- 14-36. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Foust to adopt the revised agenda. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.

Minutes of the first meeting of the 2013-2014 Board held October 9, 2013 were received for approval.

- 14-37. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Christy that the minutes of the first meeting of the 2013-2014 Board held on October 9, 2013 be approved as presented. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.

Actions from previous board meetings were reviewed.

**HEARINGS**

Mr. Paul Richard Cousins had filed a request for a hearing before the Board in regards to his previously denied professional engineer by comity application. A hearing regarding the application was conducted, and a court reporter was present in order to prepare a transcript of the proceedings.

- 14-38. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Dr. Turner that Mr. Cousins' comity application for licensure be approved and his name be included in the list of names on **Attachment 1**. MOTION CARRIED 7-0

#### **APPLICATIONS** – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor

The Board previously authorized Executive Director to approve applications for licensure, intern certification, and examinations if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. All applications for licensure, intern certification and examinations issued since the October 9, 2013 Board Meeting were reviewed.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

The Board remained in Open Session to review and consider applications with and without issues.

- 14-39. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board ratify the approval of licenses issued since the October 9, 2013 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.
- 14-40. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board ratify the approval of Intern Certifications issued since the October 9, 2013 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.
- 14-41. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Christy that the Board ratify the approval for examination those applicants approved since the October 9, 2013 meeting and listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.
- 14-42. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board approve for professional engineer licensure by comity those applicants listed on **Attachment #1** MOTION CARRIED 7-0.

- 14-43. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board deny the professional engineer license by comity applications of Michael Wagner and Brock Shepard. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.

The Board reviewed a request from Mr. Michael Crawford to consider allowing him to take additional surveying courses to meet the necessary licensure requirements instead of having to obtain another degree. Mr. Crawford had filed an application to be licensed as a professional land surveyor that was denied at the January 2011 board meeting. Mr. Crawford has a BS in Business Administration from Reinhardt University that the Board did not accept the degree as a related science or a related to surveying degree. The Board confirmed their previous ruling that Mr. Crawford would have to obtain as a minimum a related science degree in order to meet the licensing requirements.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT** – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board was briefed on the 2013 - 2014 statistics.

The Board reviewed enforcement actions taken against Alabama licensees by other licensing jurisdictions.

- 14-44. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the cases listed as LA1, SC1, AR1, GA1, OK1, and OR1 be cautioned to insure they comply with the Board's law and rules when practicing in Alabama and a copy of the letter be placed in their licensing files, and the information related to the misdemeanor criminal charges listed as TN1 and MN1 be placed in their licensing files. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action.

- 14-45. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Willis that there was probable cause that Larry Keith Dunbar, PE # 13396 provided tornado safe room design drawings that were in violation of the acceptable standards of practice of engineering in the State of Alabama. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Dunbar's professional engineer license is suspended for three years with the suspension stayed. During this stayed suspension period he is permitted to engage in the practice of engineering without limitation. He must submit payment of a \$5,000 fine to the Board, and the consent order and final order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-1 with Mr. Barter voting No and Mr. Foust recused. (Case 2013-03-B)
- 14-46. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Willis to close Case 2013-38-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Barter recused.

**CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION** – Mr. Marc S. Barter, Advisor

The Board previously authorized the Executive Director to issue certificates of authorization to applying firms if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. A list of 21

Certificates of Authorization issued to engineering firms (CA-4725-E through CA-4745-E) and a list of 3 Certificates of Authorizations issued to land surveying firms (CA-1037-LS through CA-1039-LS) since the December 4, 2013 Board Meeting were reviewed.

- 14-47. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board ratify the approval of Engineering Certificates of Authorization CA-4725-E through CA-4745-E and Land Surveying Certificates of Authorization CA-1037-LS through CA-1039-LS issued since the October 9, 2013 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.

Certificates of Authorization applications which had anomalies were discussed by the Board

- 14-48. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Mr. Willis that the Board deny the Certificate of Authorization application of Sarcor LLC, and Madison, Inc. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.
- 14-49. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Christy that the Board again deny the Certificate of Authorization application of Madison Industries Inc, and Madison, Inc. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.

#### **LEGISLATIVE – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor**

The Executive Director briefed the Board that the 2014 Legislative General Session would convene in January 2014 and can meet only 30 days within a 105-day calendar. The proposed changes to the Licensure Law have been submitted to Senator Allen; the bill has been drafted and is in the process of being pre-filed.

The Board recessed for lunch at 11:30 A.M. and the Board meeting reconvened at 1:00 P.M

#### **FINANCE – Dr. Daniel S. Turner, Advisor**

End of month financial reports for September and October, 2013 were reviewed.

The Board was briefed that even though it is self-funded, there is a requirement to submit a budget to be included in the General Fund budget. The submitted budget for FY 2014-2015 was developed based on expenditures for the 2012-2013 fiscal year and will be incorporated into the Governor's submission which will be put into a legislative bill format.

- 14-50. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board approve the proposed FY 2014-2015 budget. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.

#### **LAND SURVEYING – Mr. A. Frazier Christy, Advisor**

The Board reviewed the statistics for the October ALLS examination administered in conjunction with the NCEES exams.

- 14-51. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Willis to accept the Board's recommended cutoff score for the ALLS Examination, to approve the results of the ALLS Exam given October 25, 2013, to license the individual who passed the ALLS Exam having previously passed the FLS and PLS Exams and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing this examination be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.

### **CHAIR'S REPORT**

The Board discussed the failed 2013 legislation which included many changes to the Licensure Law that are not included in the proposed 2014 legislation. It was the Board's decision to only submit the changes to the exam references and the board quorum for the upcoming 2014 legislative session.

It was also determined that an in-depth review of the Licensure Law and the Administrative Code would be completed in order to identify additional changes to be proposed for 2015.

### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Executive Director briefed the Board that renewal processing for individual renewals began on October 1, and that those who had not provided proof of citizenship were being blocked from renewing until they provided the required documentation.

The Department of Public Examiners (state auditors) had completed the two-year financial compliance audit and the results will be provided in an out-briefing by the examiners. The contract for collection of outstanding fines/penalties is still in the Attorney General's office being reviewed, and it is not known if approval will be granted.

### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS AND CORRESPONDENCE**

The Board discussed the draft letter outlining the Board's position on the need for engineering certifications to be separate from the subdivision plat and determined additional revisions were required.

At the October 2013 Board meeting, Mr. Barter volunteered to write a proposed position statement encouraging individuals to sit for the PE examinations in the disciplines in which they are practicing. The draft position statement was discussed, and will be ready for review at the January 29, 2014 meeting.

Mr. Randy Kirkland, PE, submitted a request to the Board to consider allowing professional engineers to claim additional hours for committee/society membership. Section 330-X-13.02 of the Administrative Code was amended in 2012 to allow credit for active participation in professional and technical societies and currently allows individuals to claim 2 PDH per organization not to exceed 6 pdh total. The Board understands that involvement in some committees may involve a great deal of time and effort but they do not believe that the amount authorized to be claimed as professional

development hours should be increased.

Mr. Stephen Reaves from the National Carbon Capture Center (NCCC) have question on how to be compliant with the Licensure Law and Administrative Code in their operational facilities. Mr. Wilbanks met with Mr. Reaves at the facility to discuss their situation. NCCC is responsible for testing new technologies for capturing CO2. The equipment being shipped in for testing comes in various stages of assembly. The equipment sleds and modules come from various sources. The Board reviewed the procedures used at the Center and it is their opinion that the construction and assembly of equipment on-site at the Center needs to be under the supervision of a licensed professional engineer.

Ms. Mary Holman requested the Board to investigate the practice of allowing an affidavit in lieu of a property survey at the time of closing on the sale of property. It is Ms. Holman's contention that both the seller and buyer are practicing surveying. The use of affidavits was discussed by the Board in 2000. Letters were sent to various organizations involved real estate transactions identifying the Board's concerns with the growing use of affidavits at closings. It is the Board's opinion that while the practice of using affidavits may not be in the best interest of the parties involved, the use of the affidavits is not the practice of surveying.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

The Board reviewed the statistics for the October FE, FLS and PLS examinations administered by NCEES.

- 14-52. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Willis to accept the NCEES' recommended cutoff score for the FLS and PLS Examination, to approve the results of the FLS and PLS exams given October 2013, to license the individual who had previously passed the FLS Exam, and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing these examinations be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.
- 14-53 IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Foust to accept the NCEES' recommended cutoff score for the FE Examination, to approve the results of the FE exam given October 2013, and further that the list of those issued certification as a result of passing the examination be included in the minutes on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.

Mr. Jeff Lucas filed a request for a declaratory ruling on behalf of a public utility regarding requisite supervision deemed necessary to be in responsible charge of independent subcontractors. Mr. Lucas and Mr. Brian Horsley of Alabama Power met with the Board and outlined the methods utilized by Alabama Power to supervise surveying services provided by contractors.

- 14-54. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Willis that the that the factual situation described in which licensed professional land surveyor employees of a public utility provide oversight of subcontractors performing land surveying activities for the public utility meets the definition of "responsible charge" as outlined in the Code of Alabama and the Administrative Code of the Board. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Christy Abstaining.

## **NEWS LETTERS AND OTHER CORRESPONDENCE**

Newsletters and general correspondence not requiring a response were reviewed.

**OPEN FORUM**

Members of the public were present but did not wish to address the Board.


**CLOSING REMARKS**
