

**MINUTES OF SECOND MEETING  
2011-2012 BOARD OF LICENSURE  
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS  
Montgomery, Alabama  
December 8-9, 2011**

Chair Wilbanks called the second meeting of the 2011-2012 Board to order at 1:00 P.M., Thursday, December 8, 2011, at the Board office in Montgomery, Alabama. The following were in attendance:

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It was determined that a quorum was present.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed. The new agenda items were briefed.

12-35. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Santora to adopt the revised agenda. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Minutes of the first meeting of the 2011-2012 Board held October 12, 2011 were received for approval.

12-36. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Turner that the minutes of the first meeting of the 2010-2011 Board held on October 12, 2011 be approved as amended. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Action items from previous meetings were reviewed and updated.

**APPLICATIONS** – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor

12-37. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors go into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing pending applications. Misters Arkle, Arnold, Santora, Ulrich and Wilbanks and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Wilbanks announced the Board would reconvene into open session at approximately 3:00 P.M. The meeting was closed to the public. The meeting was opened to the public at 2:35 P.M.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by Examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(4) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

12-38. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board accept for licensure by comity those applicants listed on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

12-39. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Board accept for EI/LSI certification those applicants listed on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

12-40. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board defers for licensure/certification Vaughn J. Godet and Matthew Charles Nipper. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

12-41. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board denies for licensure/certification Jeremy Shane Spicer and Michael Robert Light. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

12-42. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Arkle that the Board approves for examination those applicants listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

12-43. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Santora that the Board defers for examination those applicants listed as deferred on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed requests for board evaluation of transcripts from applicants who wished to be considered for licensure on the basis of obtaining a related science undergraduate degree plus a master in engineering or for board evaluation of their foreign engineering degree. The Board did not rule on Sri Chandana Devi Bommareddy's request since not all transcripts were included in the request for evaluation. Ms. Bommareddy will need to provide the transcript from Clemson University in order for the Board to make an evaluation.

12-44. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Arnold that Pouria Bahmani's undergraduate degree be approved as an acceptable foreign engineering degree for the purposes of professional engineering licensure. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

12-45. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Arnold that William L. Roes, Jr.'s undergraduate degree be approved as a related science degree for the purposes of professional engineering licensure. MOTION CARRIED 5-1 with Dr. Turner voting in the negative.

#### **LAW ENFORCEMENT** – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board reviewed the list of those completed cases that are being monitored. The Board was briefed on the 2011 statistics.

The Board reviewed enforcement action taken against Alabama licensees by other licensing jurisdictions. The board identified those actions where they believed a complaint needed to be opened. The remaining licensees will be notified that copies of the actions will be placed in their Alabama licensing files.

12-46. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Arkle that the cases listed as "OK 3", "FL 1", "FL 2", and "MS 1" have complaints opened. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

12-47. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Ulrich that the cases listed as "OK 1", "OK 2", "LA 1", and "TN 1", "ID 1", and "GA 1" be notified that copies of the actions will be placed in their Alabama licensing files. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action.

12-48. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Ulrich to close Case 11-04-B and Case 11-05-B with no further action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Santora recused.

12-49. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Arkle to close Case 11-40-C with no further action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Wilbanks recused.

- 12-50. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Turner to close Case 11-46-C with a letter of reprimand. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Ulrich recused.
- 12-51. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Santora to close Case 11-48-B with a letter of reprimand. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Wilbanks recused.
- 12-52. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Ulrich to close Case 11-50-B with a letter of reprimand. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Dr. Turner recused.
- 12-53. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Turner to find Engineered Maintenance Services (EMS) and Mr. James D. Trapane guilty on the one count and to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendations with modifications. Mr. Trapane will reimburse the Board \$2,200 for the cost of hearing; EMS shall cease and desist the use of "Engineered" in the corporate name "Engineered Maintenance Services, Inc."; and EMS will have 120 days from the date of the Final Order to revise their advertising, letterhead, licenses, domains, website, and registrations with their local probate office and the Secretary of State, etc., and provide documentary proof of said changes to the Board. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Foust recused. (Case 11-32-C)

#### **CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Don T. Arkle, Advisor**

- 12-54. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Arkle that the Board ratify the approval of Engineering Certificates of Authorization CA-3161-E; 3460-E; 3473-E, and CA-4312-E through CA-4347-E issued since the October 12, 2011 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 12-55. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Arkle that the Board ratify the approval of Land Surveying Certificates of Authorization CA-300-S; 782-S; 803-S; 977-S; and 978-S issued since the October 12, 2011 Board Meeting and further that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed the certificate of authorization applications that had anomalies.

- 12-56. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Arkle to disapprove the certificate of authorization applications for ABSI-LLC and Aeroquest Optimal Inc and further, to defer action on Irby Engineering & Construction, Inc.'s application. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

#### **LEGISLATION – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor**

The Board finalized the proposed changes to the Licensure Law and discussed the process for introducing the proposed legislation during the 2012 Legislative General Session.

- 12-57. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Ulrich that the Board approves the proposed changes to the Licensure Law and directs the executive director to begin

the process of having the legislation introduced during the 2012 Legislative Session.  
MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

**FINANCE** – Dr. Daniel S. Turner, Advisor

The financial report for September and October were discussed.

The Board reviewed and approved the 2013 Budget Plan.

12-58. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board approves the proposed FY 2012-2013 budget. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

**LAND SURVEYING** – Mr. C. Michael Arnold, Advisor

The results of the October 2011 Land Surveying Examinations were briefed and approved.

12-59. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arnold to accept NCEES' recommended cutoff score for the FLS and PLS Examinations, to accept the Board's recommended cutoff score for the ALLS Examination, to approve the results of the FLS, PLS, and ALLS Exams given October 2011, to license those individuals who passed the PLS and ALLS Exams having previously passed the FLS Exam and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing these examinations be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Dr. Turner briefed the Board on the efforts already done and what still needs to be done to revise the State Specific Land Surveying Examination. The timeline for the rewrite efforts was discussed. The Board concurred with the proposed timeline; the hiring of an outside consultant to conduct training of test development; and the involvement of board members, board staff, and licensees in the development efforts. Dr. Turner will take the lead in briefing ASPLS on the rewrite efforts while encouraging them to get involved in the development workshop.

12-60. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Santora that the Board approves the expenditure of resources to begin the efforts to update the state specific land surveying examination, and further that the initial expenditure of resources is not to exceed \$10,000 for the knowledge study and examination workshop. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Those that attended the Federation of Associations of Regulatory Board (FARB) Attorney Certification Seminar provided a recap of lessons learned.

The Board reviewed the current list of NCEES emeritus members and associate members from Alabama.

12-61. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the list of NCEES emeritus members and associate members remains the same unless a former board member seeks to have his status changed. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board was briefed on the in-state travel payment procedures that will be effective January 1, 2012.

### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

The Board reviewed and adopted the proposed Qualified Based Selection (QBS) Board Position Statement.

12-62. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Santora that the Board adopts the position statement titled "Quality Based Selection of Engineering and Surveying Services." MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

### **CORRESPONDENCE**

The Board reviewed various newsletters that required no response.

The Board meeting recessed at 5:50 P.M. The Board meeting reconvened at 8:00 A.M., Friday, December 9, 2011 with all board members present.

It was noted that per the request of the individual the appearance scheduled for 8:30 A.M. was cancelled.

### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Staff briefed the Board on their research into compliance issues with the new immigration law. It was noted that the Attorney General is now issuing guidance letters since an official AG opinion will not be issued due to the fact that the legislation is under litigation. Many issues on how to comply with the legislation exist and it was agreed that guidance should be sought from the AG. Staff was directed to accept new applications and to continue the renewal process for current interns, licensees, and firms while determining who to comply with the new legislation.

12-63. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arkle that the Board Chair and Executive Director identify the questions on how to conform to the immigration law and then seek guidance from the Attorney General on those questions; and furthermore to continue to operate under the present procedures of collecting the U.S. Social Security Numbers to validate new applications and renewal applications. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

### **APPLICATIONS – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor**

The Board met with Mr. James Brazzill, a previously denied applicant. Mr. Brazzill presented a recap of his engineering experience and his education identifying that his goal is to be a licensed professional engineer. It was noted that he has obtained a BA in Mathematics and a MS in Construction Engineering Management. It was confirmed that the degrees do not meet the licensure requirement. The Administrative Code allows for a board approved four-year related science degree plus an approved masters in engineering to be considered equivalent to an unaccredited four-year engineering degree. In the case of the two degrees Mr. Brazzill has obtained, the BA in Mathematics does not meet the related science criteria and the Board has ruled that the MS in Construction Engineering

Management degree from UAB is not an acceptable either for engineering experience or as a master's degree for education licensure purposes. It was suggested to Mr. Brazzill that he might want to consider obtaining an ABET accredited BS in engineering since there has been discussion to change the administrative rules to delete the related science plus masters licensure capability as it applies to engineering licensure.

**ENGINEERING** – Mr. William C. Ulrich, Jr., Advisor

The Board met with Mr. Jonathan Stanton, a PE applicant, who wanted to discuss events that occurred at the Birmingham test site during the October 2011 offering of the PE exam. Mr. Stanton was denied entry to the exam due to having an expired driver's license as his form of identification. Mr. Stanton was able to get a new driver's license but it was after the start of the exam so access to the test site was denied. Mr. Stanton identified his concerns over this procedure. He asked that some combination of the following occur: that he be allowed to take the test out-of-cycle at a special location, that the examination fee be refunded or rolled to the next exam offering, and that the failure to take the October 2011 examination not be counted as a failed attempt. The Board explained that NCEES is responsible for the procedures followed at the test sites. All test sites within all jurisdictions are responsible for following the same procedures and that those procedures were followed properly. There will be no refund of the exam fee or rolling of the exam fee. The failure to sit for an examination is not counted as a failed attempt. The Board encouraged Mr. Stanton to continue the licensure process.

Following Mr. Stanton's appearance, the Board considered a request from Ms. Valerie Morton who was requesting a refund or rollover of the October 2011 FE examination fee due to a death in her family.

12-64. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Board disapproves Jonathan Stanton's requests. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

12-65. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Ulrich that the Board disapproves Valerie Morton's requests. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

**CORRESPONDENCE**

The Board met with Mr. Bob Barnett, PE, and Mr. Essam Ahmad, PE, who were asking the Board's guidance on if there was a threshold of when residential construction required the use of a professional engineer's services. Mr. Ahmad, the Pell City Engineer, explained that as the city engineer he has concerns that residential construction plans did not contain the seals and signatures of PE's but also questioned whether the services being provided was engineering. During the dialogue between the Board, Mr. Barnett, and Mr. Ahmad, it was noted that there was no residential exemption in the Board's licensure law similar to the one contained in the Board of Registration of Architects Licensure law. The requirement for professional engineering services in some cases is scenario dependent. The Board realizes that minor home construction may not need professional engineering services on a routine basis but that major home construction possibly includes engineering services. It was noted that the Board had previously rendered an opinion that truss design is an engineering function and requires the services of a professional engineer. The Board will not seek a licensure law change exempting residential homes. If the engineering societies feel that this is a significant issue they will have to initiate the legislation.

The Board met with Mr. Gary Gleason, PE, (City of Huntsville) and Mr. Garrett Tirpak, (Representative of Smart Vents) who were asking for the Board's opinion on whose professional engineering seal and signature needed to be on the International Code Council Evaluation Service, Inc. (ICC-ES) Evaluation Reports for engineered openings (vents). The FEMA guidelines require a PE seal and signature and the question being raised was if that PE had to be an Alabama licensed PE. It was the Board's opinion that if the vents are not manufactured in Alabama then any licensed professional engineer's seal and signature could be accepted.


**OPEN FORUM**

No comments were received during the open forum portion of the meeting.


**CLOSING REMARKS**

The next meeting of the Board for board business is scheduled for Tuesday, January 31, 2012 in Montgomery, Alabama beginning at 10:00 A.M.


