

**MINUTES OF SECOND MEETING
2009-2010 BOARD OF LICENSURE
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
Montgomery, Alabama
December 10-11, 2009**

It was determined that a quorum was present. The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed.

10-043. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Arnold to adopt the revised agenda. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Minutes of the first meeting of the 2009-2010 Board held October 8-9, 2009 were received for approval.

10-044. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Santora that the minutes of the first meeting of the 2009-2010 Board held on October 8-9, 2009 be approved as corrected. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Action items from previous meetings were reviewed.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

10-045. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Reisz that the Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors go into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing pending applications. Misters Arkle, Arnold, Reisz, Santora, Ulrich, Wilbanks, and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Ulrich announced the Board would reconvene into open session in approximately one hour at 2:35 P.M. The meeting was closed to the public. The Executive Session was concluded and the Board reconvened in Open Session at 2:55 P.M.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by Examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

10-048. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Board defer for licensure/certification Eugenio E. De Alba, Michael Vincent Pedraza, Kung Chih Ven and Manan Ramanlal Patel. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

10-049. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Board approves for examination those applicants listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

10-050. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board defer for examination John Ward Mogge III and George Todd Sims. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board reviewed the list of those completed cases that are being monitored. The Board was briefed on the 2010 statistics.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action.

- 10-051. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Arkle that probable cause exists regarding an allegation that Mr. K. Timothy Key, PLS #19521, had placed his professional seal and signature to a survey that contained violations of the standards of practice for land surveying in the State of Alabama. The approved terms of the consent order are that it will be a matter of public record, Mr. Key will pay \$500 fine to the Board, he will serve six months probation and he must attend the standards of practice for land surveying course via classroom within six months. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Reisz recused. (Case 09-289-B)
- 10-052. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Turner that probable cause exists regarding an allegation that VEAR, Inc., an un-certificated firm, published information on an internet website which made it appear the firm was offering engineering services and the Firm identified in its Articles of Incorporation that the nature of its business was engineering. The approved terms of the consent order are that this matter will be a matter of public record, VEAR will pay a \$250 civil penalty to the State General Fund, VEAR will pay \$250 to the Board for the costs associated with the investigation, VEAR will cease and desist offering engineering services until it employs a resident Alabama licensed professional engineer and obtains a certificate of authorization and VEAR will change its website to accurately reflect the office in which engineering services are performed. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Wilbanks recused. (Case 09-295-C)
- 10-053. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that probable cause exists regarding an allegation that Don G. Cochran, PE #19317 and the firm Magnolia River Services maintained a branch office without hiring a full time resident Alabama licensed professional engineer for that office and advertised via a website that engineering services were provided at that office. The approved terms of the consent order are that this matter will be a matter of public record, Mr. Cochran and Magnolia River Services will serve one year probation, Mr. Cochran will pay a \$1,000 fine to the Board, Magnolia River Services will cease and desist offering engineering services from any corporate or branch office that does not employ a full-time resident licensed Alabama professional engineer and change its website to accurately reflect the offices in which engineering services are performed. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Arnold recused. (Case 09-296-B)
- 10-054. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Turner that probable cause exists regarding an allegation that Larry A. McKinney, PE #12845 and the firm ELDECO maintained a branch office without hiring a full time resident Alabama licensed professional engineer for that office. The approved terms of the consent order are that this matter will be a matter of public record, Mr. McKinney will pay a \$500 fine to the Board, ELDECO will cease and desist offering engineering services from any corporate or branch office that does not employ a full-time resident licensed Alabama professional engineer. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Ulrich recused. (Case 09-306-B)

- 10-061. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that probable cause exists regarding an allegation that Mr. Charles B. Robison, PE #9791 had received a felony criminal conviction in the United States District Court, Northern District of Alabama for making a false statement to the Environmental Protection Agency in a certification signed by his former employer. The approved terms of the consent order are that this matter will be a matter of public record and the professional engineer license of Mr. Robison will be revoked. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Santora recused. (Case 10-03-B)
- 10-062. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Arkle to close Case 09-302-B with no further action. Mistrs Arkle, Wilbanks, Santora, Ulrich, and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion. Mr. Arnold opposed and Mr. Reisz was recused.
- 10-063. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Reisz that probable cause exists regarding an allegation that Mr. Richard W. McCoy, PE #14026, had failed to respond in a timely manner and to provide documents requested during an audit of his continuing education credits. The approved terms of the consent order are that this matter will be a matter of public record, Mr. McCoy will pay a \$200 fine to the Board and his continuing professional competency credits will be subject to audit twice within the next seven years. The Board accepted the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Wilbanks recused. (Case 09-312-B)
- 10-064. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Santora that probable cause exists regarding an allegation that Mr. Christopher B. Parker, PLS #26281, had failed to provide documents that indicated he had obtained the professional development hours necessary to renew his professional land surveyor license for 2009. The approved terms of the consent order are that this matter will be a matter of public record, the professional land surveyor license of Mr. Parker will remain in suspended

status until Mr. Parker provides documentation that indicates he has obtained the fifteen professional development hours required for his 2009 license renewal. His license to practice land surveying will be subject to one year probation beginning immediately upon the date the license suspension period terminates, he must obtain an additional fifteen professional development hours in order to renew his license to practice land surveying for 2010, he must pay the Board a fine of \$1,000 in monthly installments of \$100, his continuing professional competency credits will be subject to audit twice within the next seven years. The Board accepted the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Reisz recused. (Case 09-314-B)

- 10-065. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors go into Executive Session for the deliberating on investigative cases previously heard by the administrative law judge. Misters Arkle, Arnold, Reisz, Santora, Ulrich, Wilbanks, and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Ulrich announced the Board would reconvene into open session in approximately one hour at 5:00 P.M. The meeting was closed to the public. The Executive Session was concluded and the Board reconvened in Open Session at 4:25 P.M.

- 10-066. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Arnold to find Mr. Norman E. Close, Professional Engineer #12977, guilty on all counts and to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendations with modifications. Mr. Close will pay a \$250 fine to the Board, he will reimburse the Board \$565 for the cost of the hearing, and his professional engineer's license will be suspended until he provides documentation that verifies he has obtained fifteen professional development hours for his 2009 professional engineer license renewal. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Arkle recused. (Case 09-18-B)

- 10-067. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arnold to find Mr. Rodney R. Smith, Professional Engineer #16793, guilty on all counts and to accept the Administrative Law Judge's recommendation with modifications. Mr. Smith will reimburse the Board \$557.50 for the cost of the hearing and his Alabama professional engineer license will be revoked. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Wilbanks recused. (Case 09-316-B)

The Board reviewed enforcement action taken against Alabama licensees by other licensing jurisdictions. The licensees will be notified that copies of the actions will be placed in their Alabama licensing files.

- 10-068. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board ratify the approval of Engineering Certificates of Authorization CA-3852-E through CA-3891-E and Land Surveying Certificates of Authorization CA-906-LS through CA-910-LS

issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed the certificate of authorization applications that had anomalies.

- 10-069. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arnold to approve Casa Designs Certificate of Authorization application with the understanding that engineering services are only offered when Mr. Scot is present and the other employers of Mr. Scot offer no engineering services. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 10-070. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Arkle to deny Safe Span, LLC's Certificate of Authorization application based on its admission that services would be provided when Mr. Lundy is not present. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Arnold recused.
- 10-071. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Santora to approve Sai Ram Consultants Inc., Certificate of Authorization application with the understanding the hours of the two firms cannot overlap and the firms cannot offer engineering services when Mr. Kukkala is not present. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board recessed at 5:05 P.M. to reconvene at 8:00 A.M. The Board reconvened at 8:00 A.M. on Friday, December 11, 2009.

NEW BUSINESS

- 10-072. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Arnold that probable cause exists regarding an allegation that Mr. Dudley L. Greenway, PLS #18385, had failed to respond in a timely manner to the Board's request for documentation of his earned continuing professional competency credits and provided documents which indicated he had only obtained thirteen of the required fifteen professional development hours. The approved terms of the consent order are that this matter will be a matter of public record, Mr. Greenway will pay a \$300 fine to the Board and he must obtain two continuing professional competency credits within sixty days of the Final Order or his license to practice land surveying will be revoked. The Board accepted the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Reisz recused. (Case 09-319-B)
- 10-073. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Dr. Turner that probable cause exists regarding an allegation that Paul Lyon of Lyon Engineering Inc., an un-certificated firm, offered engineering services and placed the title "engineering" in his firm's name without employing a licensed Alabama professional engineer and obtaining a certificate of authorization for engineering from the Board. The approved terms of the consent order are that this matter will be a matter of public record, Paul Lyon will pay a \$500 civil penalty to the State General Fund, he will pay \$84 to the Board for the costs associated with the investigation, he will remove the title engineering from his firm's name, he will cease and desist offering engineering

services until he employs a full-time resident licensed Alabama professional engineer and obtains a certificate of authorization for engineering. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Wilbanks recused. (Case 09-321-C)

- 10-074. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that probable cause exists regarding an allegation that Kirk Grundahl, an unlicensed individual and his firm Qualtim, Inc., an un-certificated firm, provided a report relative to the collapse of a Church roof that was within the practice of engineering. The approved terms of the consent order are that this matter will be a matter of public record, Mr. Grundahl will pay \$1,000 to the State General Fund, he will pay \$317.70 to the Board for the costs associated with the investigation, and cease and desist offering engineering services until Firm employs a full-time resident licensed Alabama professional engineer and obtains a certificate of authorization for engineering from the Board. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Arkle recused. (Case 07-17-C)

The Board approved the April 2009 and July 2009 land surveying exam results.

- 10-075. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Arkle to accept NCEES' recommended cutoff score for the FLS and PLS Examinations, to accept the Board's recommended cutoff score for the ALLS Examination, to approve the results of the FLS, PLS, and ALLS Exams given October 23-24, 2009, to license those individuals who passed the PLS and ALLS Exams having previously passed the FLS Exam and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing these examinations be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

LEGISLATIVE – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board discussed Senate Bill 19 which was pre-filed by Senator Means and contains a proposed change to the eligibility of individuals to serve as board members. Mr. John Bowlin, American Council of Engineering Companies of Alabama (ACEC) representative in attendance at the Board meeting, briefed the Board that Senator Means advised him he intends to proceed with the bill. Chair Ulrich recommended, and the Board agreed, not to pursue its proposed changes to the licensure law regarding the structural engineering examination and computer based examinations during the 2010 legislative session.

FINANCE/PERSONNEL – Mr. Al I. Reisz, Mr. Don T. Arkle, Advisors

The reports on the receipts as well as expenditures were reviewed.

- 10-076. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Reisz and seconded by Dr. Turner that based on NCEES increasing the cost of the professional engineer and professional land surveyor examinations from \$70 to \$100 the Board submit proposed changes to the legislative reference office amending the fees charged for these examinations to reflect the new rates. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

10-077. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Reisz and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the current tiered structure of examination fees for the fundamental examinations remain unchanged. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

FORMAL HEARINGS

At the request of Mr. William H. Dawson, the Board conducted a formal hearing to render a decision on Mr. Dawson's request for reinstatement of his previously revoked professional engineer license. The Board heard testimony from Mr. Dawson and Mr. Danny Holmberg. A court reporter was present and a transcript of the hearing is on file in the office. At the conclusion of the hearing the Board determined it required an executive session to discuss Mr. Dawson's application.

10-078. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arkle that the Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors go into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing the license re-issuance application of Mr. Dawson. Misterns Arnold, Reisz, Santora, Ulrich, Wilbanks, Arkle and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Ulrich announced the Board would reconvene into open session in approximately thirty minutes at 9:50 A.M. The meeting was closed to the public. The Executive Session was concluded and the Board reconvened in Open Session at 9:45 A.M.

10-079. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Reisz to grant Mr. Dawson's request and allow for the reinstatement of Mr. William H. Dawson's professional engineering license. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

FINANCE/PERSONNEL – Mr. Al I. Reisz, Mr. Don T. Arkle, Advisors

10-080. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to approve the recommended budget for the year 2010-2011 which was submitted to the Budget Office on or before November 1, 2009. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board was briefed that based on previous instructions, the staff had submitted a proposed legal services contract for an administrative law judge to the legislative oversight committee for approval at their December 3, 2009 meeting. The committee approved the contract and it is currently awaiting the signature of the Governor.

CHAIR'S REPORT

The Board was briefed on the status of the efforts to update the Administrative Code. The staff will continue to work in conjunction with the nominating committee working group to develop recommended changes for the Board's consideration. The second meeting of the working group is scheduled to be held in February 2010 in Birmingham. Mr. Arkle will be attending as the board representative.

Committee assignments were discussed and it was agreed Board Members would continue to serve in their current committee assignments with the exceptions that Dr. Turner will now serve as advisor to

the Finance Committee and Mr. Santora will now serve as advisor to the Applications committee. The committee advisor assignments are:

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Travel to the 2010 NCEES Southern Zone Interim Meeting was approved.

- 10-081. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to authorize all board members, the board executive director, assistant executive director, and board attorney to attend the 2010 NCEES Southern Zone Interim Meeting to be held April 8-10, 2010 in Tampa, FL. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Travel to the 2010 NCEES Member Board Administrators (MBA) Meeting was approved.

- 10-082. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Arnold to authorize the board executive director and assistant executive director to attend the 2010 NCEES MBA Meeting to be held February 9-11, 2010 in Clemson, SC. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board was briefed it had previously agreed to host the 2013 Southern Zone Interim Meeting; however the Mississippi Board had requested the Alabama Board consider changing meeting host years with them. The 2012 meeting is scheduled for April 19-21, 2012. The Board determined it is agreeable to changing the meeting host year to 2012 and recommended potential meeting locations in rank order: (1) Huntsville, (2) Montgomery and (3) Point Clear, Alabama.

- 10-083. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Arkle to accept the invitation to host the 2012 Southern Zone Meeting in lieu of the 2013 meeting. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no unfinished business presented to the Board.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Board reviewed a petition from Mr. Daniel Compagno which asked the Board for a declaratory ruling on what date should be placed on revisions and/or addenda drawings. Mr. Compagno's petition included the question: Is the date next to the seal supposed to be the date of the addendum/revision or the date of the original drawing?

10-084. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Reisz to advise Mr. Compagno the licensed professional engineer should seal, sign and date original drawings when they are issued. Revisions and/or addenda to original drawings should likewise be sealed, signed and dated when they are issued. A professional best practice is that each drawing has a revision number when issued, as well as a revision history that records previous revision numbers, revision dates, initial of reviser, and a brief reference to the technical basis for the revision. Misters, Arkle, Reisz, Santora, Ulrich, Wilbanks, and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion. Mr. Arnold abstained.

The Board reviewed a petition from Mr. Daniel Compagno which asked the Board for a declaratory ruling on what constitutes direct control and supervision. Mr. Compagno's petition included the questions: (1) With the e-mail, internet and web based computer file servers and people in different offices working on the same project, what is the present day definition of "direct control" and "personal supervision"? (2) Is it permissible to stamp the work of some one that is physically located in a different office? If it is permissible, then to what extent does an engineer have to routinely review the work?

10-085. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to advise Mr. Compagno that the sealing of engineering work performed by an individual physically located in a different office than the supervising individual is possible if the licensed professional engineer providing personal supervision and in direct control of the work can meet the purpose and intent of 330-X-2-.01(16), 330-X-2-.01(3), 330-X-II-.03 (1) and the four requirements of Section 330-X-II-.03 (4) of the Board's Administrative Code. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed a letter from Mr. Steven Reeves, City of Auburn, requesting clarification from the board on the use of "Engineer" and "Surveyor" in job titles if the individuals in those positions are not licensed professional engineers or professional land surveyor respectively.

10-086. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Reisz to advise Mr. Reeves it is unlawful for any person to use in connection with his or her name the terms engineer or land surveyor unless the person has been duly licensed or is exempt from licensure. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.






