

**MINUTES OF FOURTH MEETING
2015-2016 BOARD OF LICENSURE
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
Montgomery, Alabama
March 30-31, 2016**

Chair Barter called the fourth meeting of the 2015-2016 Board to order at 8:00 A.M., Wednesday, March 30, 2016 at the Board Office, Montgomery, Alabama. The following were in attendance:

It was determined that a quorum was present.

FORMAL HEARINGS

A formal disciplinary hearing was convened at 8:05 A.M. to hear testimony concerning a complaint against Mr. Roddy Fitzgerald, regarding allegations that he had copied PE seals and signatures onto plans that were not completed by the professional engineers. Mr. Fitzgerald appeared *pro se* at the hearing. A court reporter was present and a transcript of this proceeding was requested.

Ms. Dana Billingsley, contracted Administrative Law Judge, presided at this hearing. All board members present heard evidence presented by Assistant Attorney General Mr. Benjamin Albritton. The hearing was concluded at 3:10 P.M.

Ms. Billingsley will write her findings and conclusions that will be presented to the Board at a later board meeting at which time they will deliberate.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed. Additional agenda items were identified and were added to the agenda under New Business.

16-061. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Ms. Hyde to adopt the proposed agenda as amended. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Minutes of the third meeting of the 2015-2016 Board were received for approval.

16-062. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson that the minutes of the second meeting of the 2015-2016 Board held February 9, 2016 be approved as corrected. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Action items from previous board meetings were reviewed.

The meeting adjourned at 5:20 P.M. The meeting reconvened at 8:00 A.M., Thursday, March 31st at the Board office with all board members present with the exception of Mr. Willis.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Nathan Johnson, Advisor

The Board previously authorized the Executive Director to approve applications for licensure, intern certification, and examinations if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. All applications for licensure, intern certification and examinations issued since the February 9, 2016 Board meeting were reviewed.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

16-063. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson that the Board ratify the approval of licenses issued since the February 9, 2016 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

16-064. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde that the Board ratify the approval of Intern Certifications issued since the February 9, 2016 Board Meeting and

that the list of those be included in the minutes on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

16-065. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace that the Board ratify the approval for examination those applicants approved since the February 9, 2016 meeting and listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

16-066. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Johnson that the Board defers for licensure Yuriyanto Yuriyanto and Joshua Thomas Dobson and defers for intern certification Jharith Bahjat Al Aloosi. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

16-067. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Johnson that the Board denies for licensure Matthew Bryan Hammond and Michael A. Conner. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

16-068. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Grace that the Board defer for examination those applicants listed as “deferred” on **Attachment #5**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

16-069. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Ms. Hyde that the Board deny for examination those applicants listed as “denied” on **Attachment #5**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Ms. M. Elisabeth Hyde, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board was briefed on the 2015-2016 statistics. A tentative dates were set for pending disciplinary hearings.

The Board considered a request received from David Fannon, a respondent in a case previously closed with an informal action. Mr. Fannon had appealed the Board’s action to Circuit Court of Montgomery County. The Court remanded the case back to the Board to consider Mr. Fannon’s request to remove the reprimand and hold the investigation open pending the conclusion of separate litigation filed by Mr. Fannon.

16-070. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Johnson to reopen the closed case, deny the request for the case to be put on hold and to set the matter for hearing. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Barter recused.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action. Cases that are being recommended for closure or where they are recommendations from the investigative committee are discussed in a sanitized format so that in the event the Board suggests another course of action that the due process of the investigation has not been compromised. Respondent’s information is not divulged until after a proposed consent order is accepted and a final order is approved.

16-071. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Grace to accept the proposed Consent Order and issue the Final Order for Cases 2013-37-B, 2013-42-B, 2014-12-B, and 2015-11-B. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. Richard Borden, PE #13402 and PLS #13402 had violated various sections of the licensure law and Code of Ethics in the conducting of his professional engineering and professional land surveying practice. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are Mr. Borden's engineering and surveying license are suspended for four years, (with the suspension stayed), he must pay a fine of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), and investigation costs of (\$2,225) to the Board in 8 quarterly payments. The first payment (\$1,529) is included with the Order and the remaining payments of (\$1,528) begin July 1, 2016; and he must provide a monthly list of the engineering and land surveying projects he performs for a period of two years beginning May 15, 2016. Mr. Borden also understands the Board may select any of the projects on the list for review and he will be required to submit all documentation related to those projects to the Board. He agrees to establish office procedures that insure clients and potential clients are provided a document that outlines the scope of services of the work he will perform and the work that will be performed under his direct supervision. The document must also include language that requires client authorization for changes to the agreed upon scope of services. A copy of these documents must also be available for inspection by Board staff. Mr. Borden agrees to allow Board staff to inspect his office records during normal business hours, he agrees to complete the three professional development hour course (Incident at Morales) sponsored by the Murdough Center for Engineering Professionalism at Texas Tech University within six months of the date of the Final Order with the understanding this course cannot be used to meet the pdh requirements for license renewal. Mr. Borden agrees any violation of the terms of this Consent Order could result in the Board removing the stay from the suspension. The Consent Order and Final Order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Barter recused.

16-072. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson to close Case 2015-21-B with no formal action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Ms. Hyde recused.

16-073. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Christy to accept the proposed Consent Order and issue the Final Order for Case 2015-51-B. It was determined that there was probable cause the Mr. W. M. Varnon, PLS #9324, had multiple standards of surveying violations. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are Mr. Varnon must pay a \$2,000 fine to the Board, his license will be suspended (with that suspension stayed for 2 years, he must provide to the Board upon request a list of the surveying jobs performed within a one month period during the stayed suspension period. The surveys will be randomly selected for review for compliance with the standards of practice. The Consent Order and Final Order will be a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Johnson recused.

16-074. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Johnson to close Case 2016-07-C with no formal action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Barter recused.

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Marc S. Barter, Advisor

The Board previously authorized the Executive Director to issue certificates of authorization to applying firms if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. A list of the certificate of authorizations issued since the February 2016 Board Meeting were reviewed.

16-075. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Grace and seconded by Mr. Johnson that the Board ratify the approval of the Engineering and Land Surveying Certificates of Authorization issued since the February 2016 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board discussed the Certificate of Authorization applications that had exceptions.

16-076. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Grace to approve the application for Bumpers Land Surveying LLC. MOTION CARRIED 4-2 with Mr. Barter and Mr. Christy voting in the negative.

16-077. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to deny the application for Atlantic Engineering Services LLC. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

16-078. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace to deny the application for L I Smith & Associates, Inc. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

16-079. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Grace to approve the application for Intersol LLC. MOTION CARRIED 5-1 with Mr. Barter voting in the negative.

LEGISLATURE – Ms. M Elisabeth Hyde, Advisor

Legislation that had been filed in the 2016 General Session was briefed.

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY – Mr. Marc S. Barter, Advisor

The Board was briefed on the progress of the continuing education audit. Options were discussed on how to simplify the audit process. It was decided to research if a pre-selection process where the licensees are notified prior to renewal that they have been selected for audit would streamline the process. If the necessary documents are not provided the individual would not be allowed to renew.

LAND SURVEYING – Mr. A. Frazier Christy, Advisor

The Board approved the results of the February 2016 state specific surveying examination.

16-080. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson to accept the Board's recommended cutoff score for the ALSS Examination, to approve the results of the

ALSS Exam given February 17, 2016, to license the individuals who passed the ALSS Exam having previously passed the FLS and PLS Exams and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing these examinations be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The agenda for the upcoming NCEES Southern Zone Interim Meeting was reviewed.

Opportunities for attending meetings throughout the state were identified. It was emphasized that the priority should be to get a space on the programs instead of just having someone sit at a vendor table with little interaction while the educational seminars are in session. It was also decided that the board should continue to host educational webinars.

16-081. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson that there should be two board sponsored webinars per year. MOTION CARRIED 6-0

The senior staff members and the board members discussed the setting of timelines and deadlines for the various projects being completed by staff. It was clarified that the Request for Quotes for technical assistance in enforcement should fall into two categories – pre and post investigation. The executive director identified that a master deadline calendar that includes timelines is being produced. Also all the continuity books are being updated and where necessary are being initially created.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Board considered a request for a declaratory ruling that was received from the City of Wetumpka. The city was asking for a clarification whether a city had to employ a professional engineer to oversee the construction of all public works. The issue was discussed and it was determined that the answer was no citing Section 330-X-2(18) of the Administrative Code. A ruling will be drafted and provided to the Board for approval.

The Board approved a request from Mr. Charles Bowden who was requesting that he be reimbursed the reinstatement fee that he had paid for renewing his firm's CA after the January 31, 2016 deadline. His failure to renew was due to the death of his wife during the open renewal period.

16-082. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to authorize the reimbursement of \$250.00 to Mr. Charles Bowden. MOTION carried 6-0.

The Board considered a request from Mr. Drew Hains. Mr. Hains was asking if the Board considered Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering as engineering disciplines. In his letter Mr. Hains cites that there are no references to those disciplines in the definition of "Practice of Engineering" although there are degrees awarded and NCEES has a Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering Discipline for the PE exam. It was the Board's opinion that the definition of "Practice of Engineering" is not an inclusive list and is reflective of the types of work that is considered engineering. Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering is a recognized discipline of engineering.

NEW BUSINESS

The status of the staff was discussed. It was explained that other than the executive director's position the deputy director's position, and the assistant secretary's position all the other staff were assigned to merit system positions. It was explained that for merit employees performance reports and merit raises are governed by the rules of state personnel. Discussions ensued on the best way to categorize the pay series for the non-merit positions. It was requested that job descriptions be created where they are missing and then performance reviews will be accomplished. The completed documents will be used when the Board considers whether raises should be requested for the executive director and deputy director.

It was noted that Mr. Keith Maxwell appears to using domain names on web sites that may be misleading. Staff was instructed to open an investigation.

The Board approved the proposed Position Statement of Subdivision Certification Statements and the proposed Declaratory Ruling on Supervision and Direct Control.

16-083. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to adopt both opinions.
MOTION CARRIED 6-0.




